

Our Projects



We support a number of projects in Ahotokurom including:

Child Sponsorship scheme

Regular donors commit to supporting the children that Ahotokurom cares for. This ensures the children are loved, fed, have access to medical care and receive an education. Donors pay £180 per annum to support a child.

Scholarship Programme

Our scholarships are awarded to support vocational education. Young people train as carpenters, mechanics, seamstresses, caterers, administrators etc. Through this they can then support themselves and their families.

Special Education

Those with disabilities do not get the opportunity for an education. The Special Needs School provides education for all children with physical or learning disabilities. The focus is on life and social skills enabling children to reach their fullest potential.

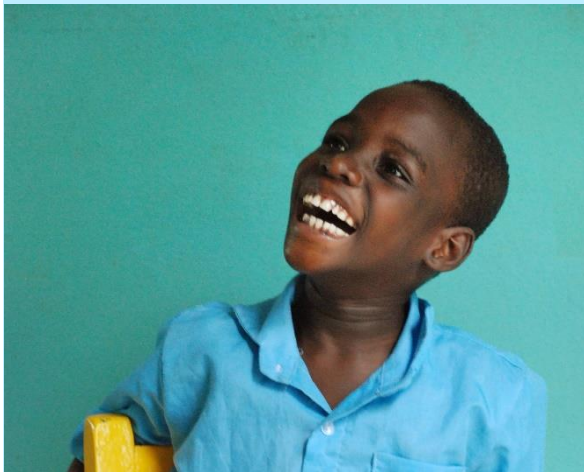
